

Weapons Policy

No person shall possess, on library property, a weapon of any kind, unless authorized by law.

Any person violating this section shall be denied entrance to the building or ordered to leave the building. Any library employee violating this section shall be disciplined.

City of Sedalia Policy- ec. 36-124. Firearms in city buildings.

- (a) No person who has been issued a concealed carry endorsement by the state director of revenue under RSMo 571.101 et seq., or who has been issued a valid permit or endorsement to carry concealed firearms issued by another state or political subdivision of another state, shall, by authority of that endorsement or permit, be allowed to carry a concealed firearm or to openly carry a firearm in any building or portion of a building, including all city parks, owned, leased or controlled by the city.
- (b) Signs shall be posted at each entrance of a building entirely owned, leased or controlled by the city stating that the carrying of firearms is prohibited. Where the city owns, leases or controls only a portion of a building, signs shall be posted at each entrance to that portion of the building stating that the carrying of firearms is prohibited.
- (c) This section shall not apply to buildings used for public housing by private persons, highways or rest areas, firing ranges, or private dwellings owned, leased or controlled by the city.
- (d) Any person violating this section may be denied entrance to the building or to the city park, or ordered to leave the building or city park. Any city employee violating this section may be disciplined. No other penalty shall be imposed for a violation of this section.
- (e) No person who has been issued a certificate of qualification which allows the person to carry a concealed firearm before the director of revenue begins issuing concealed carry endorsements in July 2004, shall, by authority of that certificate, be allowed to carry a concealed firearm or to openly carry a firearm in any building or portion of a building or city park, owned, leased or controlled by the city.
